Oatmeal Health was founded on a mission to end missed lung cancer. The smoking history that makes someone eligible for screening is often buried in clinical notes or missing altogether, so most eligible patients are never screened. LungIQ finds them in the medical record, and LungAI gives radiologists an AI second opinion on every low-dose lung CT, scoring each nodule for cancer risk. LungAI is investigational and not FDA 510(k) cleared.

Products

LungIQ. Finds patients in a health center's records who qualify for lung cancer screening but have not been screened, and helps care teams refer them. Works from a standard data export, no EHR integration needed.

LungAI. Gives radiologists a 0 to 100 malignancy score for every lung nodule on a screening CT, inside the CADe viewer they already use. Investigational, not FDA 510(k) cleared.
